Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel CoronaVirus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts.

Public Health Action Taken

- 1. To combat the COVID-19 pandemic, one more laboratory has been approved by ICMR. Now Uttarakhand is having 3 labs out of 265 labs present in the country.
- 2. To combat the ongoing outbreak of COVID-19, the government has issued directions to earmark 3-tier health facilities for COVID-19 patients.
- 3. The Government has issued directions to all District Magistrates to ensure the promotion of 'Aarogya Setu' app among citizens of the state so as to make the citizens aware about COVID-19 pandemic.
- 4. Directions have been given to all Chief Medical Officers to ensure psychiatrist counselling to passengers/ people quarantined in identified quarantine facilities.

APPEAL

Department of Health and Family Welfare, Uttarakhand appeals to all citizens of the state to follow the advisory for lockdown. All persons who have been advised quarantine (Contacts of Positive cases and people who have come from outside the state) have to observe mandatory home quarantine as instructed by authorities. They may stay in separate room and not venture outside their house.

Preventive Measures

- 1. All citizens must wear masks whenever venturing outside of their homes.
- 2. Facility quarantine of all asymptomatic travelers for next 28 days after returning from outside Uttarakhand.
- 3. Travelers and their family members must ensure strict respiratory and hand hygiene. Cover your face while coughing or sneezing, wash hands frequently and avoid handshakes.
- 4. Travelers who have come from COVID-19 affected regions, must report to district/block health authorities immediately, if they develop any symptoms like fever, cough, cold or difficulty in breathing. Helpline/war room no. is 01352609500/104.
