Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized **38** dedicated COVID Hospitals and **420** COVID Care Centres (CCC).

Public Health Action Taken

- To enhance the COVID-19 testing capacity, the State Government has decided to conduct 24x7 testing facility in Govt. Medical College Haldwani, Dehradun & Srinagar Garhwal.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced **Home Isolation** strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- To facilitate the early management of COVID-19 positive patients, the State Government has designated 20 Private Hospitals as COVID dedicated facility.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.

Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:

- **Treated & Cured:** One Hundred Seventy-Three (173) patients discharged in different districts (Almora– 02, Bageshwar– 19, Chamoli– 03, Champawat– 00, Dehradun– 74, Haridwar– 17, Nainital– 06, Pauri– 01, Pithoragarh– 00, Rudraprayag– 07, Tehri– 33, U.S. Nagar– 00 & Uttarkashi– 11).
- **Death:** Eleven (11) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
 - (1) A 64-year-old male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Severe Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Acute Kidney Injury.
 - (2) A 42-year-old male expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Refractory Septic Shock, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, COVID Pneumonia & Decompensated Alcoholic Liver Disease.
 - (3) An 85-year-old male expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Cardiac Arrest, COVID Pneumonia, Septic Shock.
 - (4) A 53-year-old male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 1 Respiratory Failure & Acute kidney Injury.
 - (5) A 55-year-old male expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to COVID Pneumonitis, Ventricular Arrhythmia, Septicemia & Septic Shock.
 - (6) A 61-year-old female expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 1 Respiratory Failure & Acute Coronary Syndrome.
 - (7) A 72-year-old male expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Severe COVID Pneumonia & Septic Shock.
 - (8) A 68-year-old female expired in Shri Mahant Indresh Hospital, Dehradun due to Bilateral Pneumonitis, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Multiple Organ Dysfunction Syndrome, Acute on Chronic Kidney Disease & Sepsis.
 - (9) A 52-year-old Male native of Delhi, expired from SMIH Dehradun due to Sudden Cardio-Pulmonary Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonia.
 - (10) A 32-year-old Male native of Dehradun, expired from SMIH Dehradun due to Cardio-Pulmonary Arrest.
 - (11) A 56-year-old Male expired from District Tehri Garhwal, cause of death is awaited.

Preventive measures


1. All citizens must wear masks whenever venturing outside of their homes.
