















Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized 38 dedicated COVID Hospitals and 422 COVID Care Centres (CCC).

Public Health Action Taken

- To further increase the COVID-19 testing, the Government has lowered down the testing charges for both RT-PCR and Rapid Antigen COVID-19 test.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced Home Isolation strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.

Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:

- Treated & Cured: Five Hundred Eight (508) patients discharged in different districts (Almora- 17, Bageshwar- 03, Chamoli- 78, Champawat- 09, Dehradun- 190, Haridwar- 55, Nainital- 07, Pauri- 103, Pithoragarh 28, Rudraprayag 07, Tehri 07, U.S. Nagar 00 & Uttarkashi 04).
- Death: Nine (09) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
 - (1) A 45 year old female expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to COVID Pneumonia.
 - (2) A 58 year old male expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Sepsis, Septic Shock, COVID Pneumonia & Hospital Acquired Pneumonia.
 - (3) A 67 year old male expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to Type 1 Respiratory Failure, Acute Kidney Injury & Sepsis.
 - (4) A 53 year old male expired in Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun due to Bilateral Pneumonitis, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Type 1 Respiratory Failure.
 - (5) A 33 year old female expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehradun due to CardioPulmonary Arrest.
 - (6) A 54 year old female expired in Himalayan Hospital, Dehradun due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Septic Shock.
 - (7) A 89 year old male expired in Kailash Hospital, Dehradun due to CardioRespiratory Arrest.
 - (8) A 65 year old female expired in DH, Gopeshwar due due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Pneumonia.
 - (9) A 72 year old male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Severe Acute Respiratory Infections, Bilateral Pneumonitis & Acute Kidney Injury.



APPEAL


